VISITOR POLICY

- Wear a well-fitting non-surgical paper mask or a mask of higher quality (ie, KN95 or N95) always during your visit at the facility.
- Please sanitize your hands upon entering the lobby, throughout your visit, before/after touching your loved one and again after your visit.
- You will sign in using the Facial Recognition Screening Kiosk to sign in and out of facility. You will be asked to answer the Health Questionnaire and agree to the facility terms and conditions. Once you have completed that, a badge will be printed for you to wear while in the facility.
- Staff must verify that visitors have received a negative SARS-CoV-2 test result within one day
 prior to visitation for antigen tests (Rapid test) and two days prior to visitation for NAAT (e.g.,
 PCR) tests. All visitors may use either NAAT testing or antigen testing. This means, for example,
 that a test for a Sunday visit should be conducted no earlier than Saturday if it is an antigen test
 or Friday if it is a PCR test.
- Staff should provide a visitor with an Antigen Rapid Test if he/she does not have other valid proof of a negative test conducted in the required time frame, and the visitor should test him/herself at the facility.
- Visitors that refuse testing will be denied entry and authorities will be contacted to remove them from the facility.
- Indoor visits will be allowed in the residents' rooms.
- Please maintain 6 feet social distancing from others.
- Please observe coughing etiquette (cough into elbow or tissue, discard tissue, then wash your hands with soap & water of use hand sanitizer).
- Failure to adhere to the above will require the visit to be stopped immediately.

Any visitor that shows signs or symptoms of COVID-19 will be prohibited from visiting.

Some signs and symptoms of COVID:

Fever/Chills	Sore Throat
Dry Cough	Headache
Fatigue	Loss of Taste or Smell
Difficulty breathing	Runny Nose/Congestion
Muscle/Body aches	Chest pain/pressure
Nausea/Vomiting	Diarrhea
